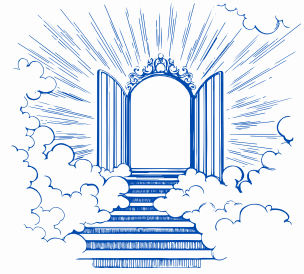


# CHRISTIANITY 101 LESSON 11: THE LAST THINGS

The "Last Things" is an area of theology with a lot of debate. As this is a 101 class, lets first focus on areas of common agreement

- We believe Jesus will return - John 14:3; Acts 1:11; Titus 2:13
- We believe in the resurrection of the dead - 1 Thess 4:13-17
- We believe in the judgment of God - 2 Corinthians 5:10, Hebrews 6:10, James 1:12 (Crown Verse)
- We believe in the ultimate glorification of all believers - 1 Corinthians 15:50
- We believe a unified theology regarding the sequence of last events is not essential to salvation

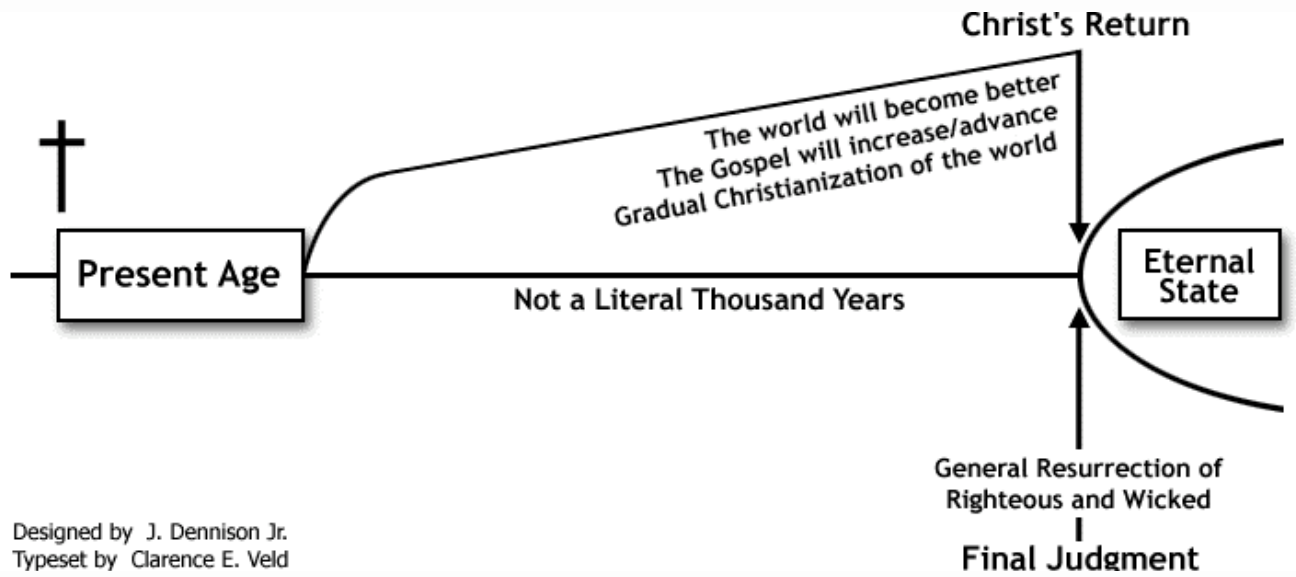
Some areas of vast disagreement w/ key definition of terms:

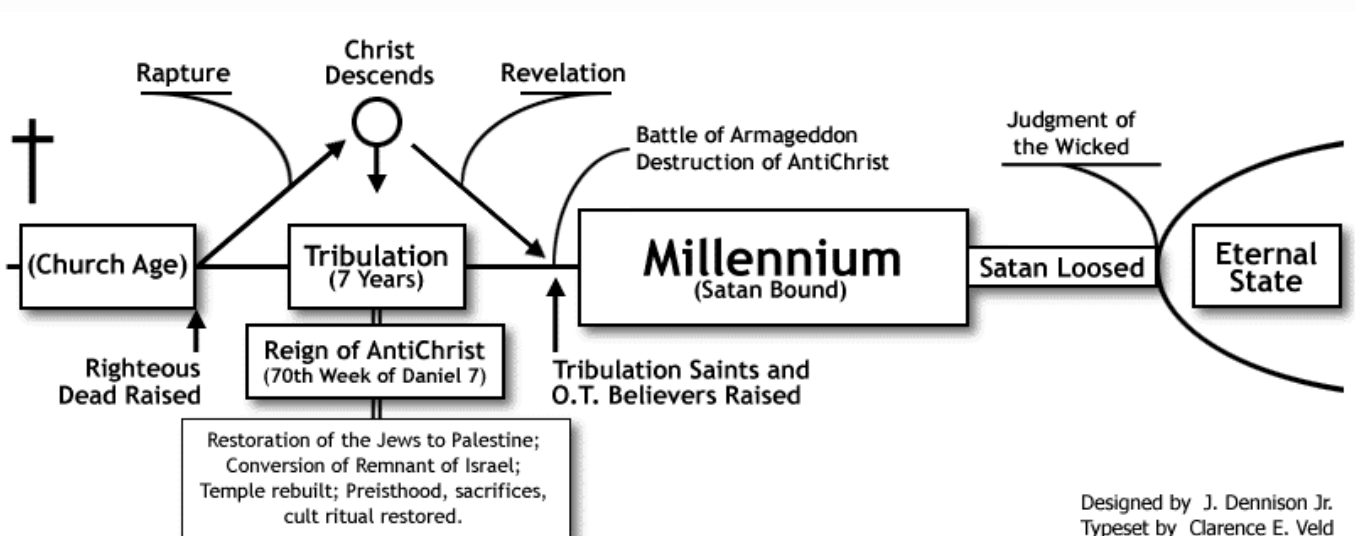
